*** Plan to Participate:**

Treating therapists and all members of the child's support team are welcome to attend and/or collaborate with the gait clinic

*** Gait Clinic Billing Information:**

If the child is receiving ongoing services using Early Intervention funding through the state of Illinois (EI) and the child's PT is a credentialed evaluator, the gait clinic time can be billed by the treating PT in order to allow for participation of the treating therapist.

If the PT provider is not a credentialed evaluator and assessment is required, BDI Playhouse credentialed EI evaluators can assess and bill through EI with appropriate authorization.

If the child did not qualify for PT or is not currently receiving PT services through EI, insurance will be billed. If insurance does not cover, a reasonable private pay fee will be assessed.

BDI Playhouse works in collaboration with the orthotists at Hanger Clinics in Westchester, II, for our gait clinic. Hanger does not bill for assessment or follow-up appointments. If an orthotic is recommended and the family chooses to order through Hanger Clinics, these appliances will be billed directly by Hanger Clinics.
